PROGRAM ASSISTANT TRAINING.

Our Program Assistants (PA'S) are a great asset to our skating programs. These girls and boys come from our Starskater sessions. They are there to assist the coaches during the Canskate and Pre-Canskate sessions. The younger skaters really look up to our older skaters. If your skater wishes to volunteer as a PA this year, they must be 12 years of age or older, and attend the PA training session on:

Thursday, Sept 6th from 6:15 – 7:45 pm. Session to be held at the Sportsplex.

Registration is available under the Fall-Winter reg Season. There is a fee of \$1.00 to register but you do not have to pay. Just exit the page without paying the \$1.00.

REGISTRATION EVENT.

Langley Skating Club will be hosting a registration event on Wednesday September 5th from 6 – 8:30 pm.

Location will be the George Preston Arena. Rooms A & B. This is a great chance to come out and ask questions of both the Board Members and the coaches. This is also an opportunity for you to touch base with coaches regarding your child's skating development or placement.

Hot dogs and drinks will be provided by donation. On site registration will also be available.

Skate/Equipment swap. Wednesday Sept 5th. 6 – 8:30.

As part of this event we would like to run a skating equipment swap. Bring your skating items that evening. Make sure your name is on each item, as well as the price and your phone number. All items must be picked up by the end of the evening.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION.

Please note!!! ***All Starskate sessions are priced Sept -March.***

Canskate and Pre-Canskate sessions are offered Sept – Dec or Sept – March.

There will be an early bird discount applied to all registrations in by Sept 3rd midnight.

Registrations up to \$500.00 will receive a 5% discount.

Registrations over \$500.00 will receive a 10% discount.

Payment plans are also available when registering for multiple sessions.

Discounts and payment plans do not apply to Pre-Season Ice, Costume fees, PA Training, Synchro or Passion Dance classes.

PROGRAM INFORMATION.

Canskate/Pre-Canskate.

Sessions fees are for the period of Sept to Dec or Sept to March.

Sept – March 2 day a week packages available for Canskate. Click on word packages at top of program page.

Mon & Wed classes at Sportsplex. Tues classes at George Preston Arena.

Sept. - March classes. Monday 22 classes. Tuesday 24 classes. Wednesday 24 classes.

Sept. – Dec. classes. Monday 13 classes. Tuesday 15 classes. Wednesday 14 classes.

There will be registration in Dec for Jan to March sessions. Canskate and Pre-Canskate only.

No skating Mondays Oct 8th, Nov 12th, and Feb 18th.

Early start time Tuesday Nov 20th. 5:00 pm Canskate & 5:15 Pre-Canskate.

Late Entry Figure Skating. LEFS.

This session is for skaters aged 13 thru Adult who want to learn how to figure skate in a non-competitive environment.

Coaching fees are included in the session pricing.

Sessions are priced for Sept – March. Tues 23 classes. Wed has 24 classes.

No skating on Tuesday Nov 20th, Wed Oct 31st.

Jr Academy.

For those skaters who have just completed Canskate or those Star Skaters that have not yet passed any tests. Working on Star 1 & 2. **This is a minimum 2 day a week program.**

Session fees include coaching at a ratio of 3 coaches per 12 skaters.

Each session consists of 1 hr of ice time and 30 min of dryland.

Sessions fees are for the period of Sept – March. Monday has 22 classes, Thursday has 25 classes, and Friday has 23 classes.

No skating Mondays, Oct 8th, Nov 12th, and Feb 18th and Friday Nov 30th.

Skaters who are registered in Jr Academy or Jr/Int Star programs at least two days a week will receive a \$100.00 credit towards their Synchro Program Expenses when they register for our Synchro Team as well.

Starskaters:

Level Requirements.

Jr. level requirements are no tests passed. Working on Star 1 & 2.

Int. level requirements are Working on completing Star 3 & 4. Must have passed Star 2.

Sr. level requirements are Working on Star 5 and up. Must have passed Star 4.

Sessions run from Sept thru March. The coaching fee is included in many of the sessions. These are clearly marked on the attached document. The coaching ratio is min 2 coaches for 10 skaters.

Mondays sessions have 22 classes. **No skating Oct 8th, Nov 12th, Feb 18th.**

Tuesday sessions have 24 except Jr/Int Free+Spins/Dev which has only 21 classes. **No Jr/Int November 20th.**

Wednesday sessions have 25 classes.

Thursday's have 25 classes.

Friday's have 24 classes. **No skating Nov 9th & Nov 30th.**

Saturday's have 20 classes. **No Skating Nov 10th, Dec 1st, Jan 5th, Feb 16th.**

Synchronized Skating. Beginner Level.

This is a team sport which consists of a min of 8 skaters who work on a choreographed routine to perform at several competitions in the new year. This year's team will be a Beginner aged team. Skaters aged 6 – 12 are welcome. Canskaters wanting to join the team must be at a min level of 4. Practices are Wednesday Night at the Sportsplex. 6:30 – 7:30 pm. There will also be 30 min of Dryland added either before or after the class.

Placement on teams will be determined by the Coach and will be based on age, as well as skill level.

Skaters who are registered in Jr Academy or Jr/Int Star programs at least two days a week will receive a \$100.00 credit towards their Synchro Program Expenses when they register for our Synchro Team as well.

Passion Dance Class.

This popular Saturday morning class is back. This class is specifically designed for our skaters. Skaters will be working on building body strength, flexibility, and balance. Highly recommended by our coaches. The session will start and end before and after our ice schedule. Sept 8th – April 13th. A total of 24, 1 hr classes for \$225.00. Minimum 6 participants required. Register under Fall-Winter Reg. Passion Dance.

Bi-annual Ice Show. Saturday March 9th. Two performances, Aft & Even.

As many of you already know, the ice show requires a huge amount of volunteer hrs to make it happen. All families (except those Canskaters who are skating Sept – Dec only) are required to volunteer either in the planning and preparation and/or at the actual performance. **Volunteer bonds (Post dated cheques made out to LSC and dated for March 9th 2019) will be collected at the beginning of the Sept sessions.**

Canskate, Pre-Canskate and LEFS \$50.00 per family. Min 4 hrs required.

Jr Academy, Jr Star, Int Star, and Sr Star \$125.00 per family. Min 8 hrs required.

If you volunteer for the club the min hrs required, your cheque will not be cashed.

Ice Show Costume fee will be added to your reg fee.

As with the last show in 2016, we will be co-ordinating and purchasing the costumes for all skaters. The cost will be added to your registration fee. Canskaters will have a \$50.00 fee, and Jr Academy, LEFS, and all Star Skaters will have a \$75.00 fee. This fee will be for 1 costume only. Those skaters that skate in multiple lines, will be required to pay for any additional costumes.
