PROGRAM ASSISTANT TRAINING.

Our Program Assistants (PA'S) are a great asset to our skating programs. These girls and boys come from our Starskater sessions. They are there to assist the coaches during the Canskate and Pre-Canskate sessions. The younger skaters really look up to our older skaters. If your skater wishes to volunteer as a PA this year, they must be 12 years of age or older, and attend the PA training session on:

Thursday, Sept 5th from 3:15 – 4:45 pm. Session to be held at the Sportsplex.

Registration is available under the Fall-Winter reg Season. There is a fee of \$1.00 to register but you do not have to pay. Just exit the page without paying the \$1.00.

There will be an early bird discount applied to all registrations in by Sept 4th midnight.

Registrations up to \$500.00 will receive a 5% discount.

Registrations over \$500.00 will receive a 10% discount.

Payment plans are also available when registering for multiple sessions. You can make online payments by charge card or pay pal. Post dated cheques can also be used.

Discounts and payment plans do not apply to Pre-Season Ice, PA Training, or Synchro.

There will be registration in Dec for Jan to March sessions. Canskate and Pre-Canskate only.

Late Entry Figure Skating. LEFS.

This session is for skaters aged 13 thru Adult who want to learn how to figure skate in a non-competitive environment.

Coaching fees are included in the session pricing.

Sessions are priced for Sept – March. Tues 20 classes. Wed has 25 classes.

No skating on Tuesdays Nov 19th, Dec 3rd, Dec 17th, Jan 21st, & Feb 4th.

Invited to Christmas Skate on Wed Dec 18th. 5:45 – 6:30. Sportsplex.

Jr Academy.

For those skaters who have just completed Canskate or those Star Skaters who have not yet passed any tests. Working on Star 1 & 2. **This is a minimum 2 day a week program.**

If you are unable to attend either the Monday or Thursday Jr Academy class, your second day can be Jr/Int Free + Spins/Development on Tuesdays.

Session fees include coaching at a ratio of 3 coaches per 12 skaters.

Monday session consists of 1 hr of ice time from 3:30 – 4:30 and 30 min of dryland from 4:45 – 5:15.

Thursday session consists of 30 min of dryland from 4:00 – 4:30 and 60 min of ice time from 4:45 – 5:45.

Sessions fees are for the period of Sept – March. Mon has 22 classes, Tues has 20, Thurs has 23 classes.

No skating Mondays, Oct 14th, Nov 11th, and Feb 17th.

No skating Tues, Nov 19th, Dec 3rd, Dec 17th, Jan 21st, Feb 4th.

Starskaters:

Level Requirements.

Jr. level requirements are no tests passed. Working on Star 1 & 2.

Int. level requirements are Working on completing Star 3 & 4. Must have passed Star 2.

Sr. level requirements are Working on Star 5 and up. Must have passed Star 4.

Sessions run from Sept thru March. The coaching fee is included for all Jr/Int sessions. Sr Dryland and Open Development also include coaching fees. These are clearly marked on the attached document. The coaching ratio is 3 coaches for 12 skaters.

Mondays sessions have 20am & 22pm classes. **No skating Oct 14th, Nov 11th, Feb 17th. No am Jan 20th & 27th.**

Tuesday sessions have 20 classes. **No skating Nov 19th, Dec 3rd, Dec 17th, Jan 21st & Feb 4th.**

Wednesday sessions have 25 classes. Sr Free has 24. **No Sr Fee Nov 6th Simulation Day.**

Thursday's have 23 classes. **No skating Oct 31st & Jan 23rd.**

Friday's have 21pm & 22am classes. **No skating Oct 11th, Nov 8th & Feb 14th. AM only on Nov 29th.**

Saturday's have 17 classes. **No Skating Oct 12th, Nov 9th, Nov 30th, Jan 18th & 25th, & Feb 15th.**

Synchronized skating Pre-Novice Level.

This team is in place and has already been working on their choreography for competition. They will practice on Wednesday nights from 6:30 – 8:15 pm at the Sportsplex.

Placement on teams will be determined by the Coach and will be based on age, as well as skill level.

VOLUNTEER BONDS.

All Starskaters will be charged a volunteer bond. \$300.00 per family. These cheques must be put into place by the first week of skating. Made out to LSC and post dated to March 12th, 2020. For the 2019-2020 Fall/Winter session all Starskate families are expected to volunteer with the club for a min of 8 hrs. **Langley Skating Club will be hosting** a Skate Canada Super Series Competition, (Winter Skate) from Jan 31st – Feb 2nd at the Sportsplex. We are going to require many hrs of pre-planning and countless volunteer hrs to help make this 3-day event a success. **It is our turn to host, so let's make sure we do a job to be proud of.**

STARS ON ICE.

This is a bi-ennial event. Stars on Ice will take place on Tuesday March 10th for George Preston Skaters and Wednesday, March 11th for Sportsplex skaters.
